Parking

Civilian Enforcement Officers (CEO's) deal with the following parking issues: Limited waiting bays, double/single yellow lines, on street pay and display bays, residents' parking zones, Blue Badge bays, loading bays, bus stops, taxi bays, school keep clears, clearways, car parks (with orders), dropped kerb access (also police), double parking (also police), pedestrian crossings (also police).

Members of the public can report direct to: parking@derbyshire.gov.uk and 01629538671.

Police Officers are responsible for enforcing:

Double white lines, obstruction – for example, pavements with no parking restrictions, Dangerous parking where there are no restrictions in place, for example, on bends, brows of hills and junctions, one-way traffic, box junctions, access only, white-hatched areas, pedestrian crossings (also CEOs), dropped kerb access (also CEOs), double parking (also CEOs).

Speeding:

CREST (Casualty Reduction Enforcement Support Team) now have a website and an online 'Reporting' facility to report speeding issues/locations. These are then collated and can be actioned by CREST.
