Let's face it, no-one likes dog mess. It affects our pavements, footpaths and green spaces. Not only is it anti-social, offensive & unsightly, it also poses a serious risk to health.

FIVE REASONS TO PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG......



1. It gets on your boots, on pushchairs, wheelchairs, in your house, and in your car.

2. Dog mess can harbour diseases such as E. coli and Salmonella, as well as worms and eggs – which can all be passed onto humans. Children who often play in grassed areas, or woodland frequented by dog walkers, are most at risk.





3. Dog mess is NOT a fertiliser, it is a POLLUTANT. It kills grass, and damages crops (think: the crops your dog messes in, ends up in our food chain – yuk!)

4. It is anti-social not to clean up after your dog, and by failing to do so, you run the risk of being reported to South Derbyshire Safer Neighbourhood Wardens, who will investigate ALL complaints.

5. ABOVE ALL, IT IS PART AND PARCEL OF BEING A RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNER

Remember, your dog is also at risk from dog mess.

Parvo Virus, and parasites such as roundworms and tapeworms, can be spread through contact with infected dog faeces.
