Cadley Park Grand Opening

On Saturday 15th April, Cadley Park was official opened alongside the Harworth Group's nearby Coronation Park.

Cadley Park is a fantastic new facility off William Nadin Way in Swadlincote which offers a vibrant new area where people can enjoy the outdoors, with walking and cycle paths, a learn to ride area and a pump track.

At the opening event our team were onsite to deliver cycling opportunities on the learn to ride area and we partnered up with TUFF Riders who delivered coaching session on the pump track throughout the day as well as pro-rider Ashley Tew who showed off his skills!

As part of the funding agreement with Sport England and British Cycling who we secured money from to make this project a reality, we will now be looking to schedule further events and sessions at the new site alongside the everyday recreational use it is already facilitating.

Beat the Street Swadlincote has come to an incredible conclusion after the game came to an end at 7pm on Wednesday, 26th April.

The game saw 6,496 people walking, cycling and rolling an incredible 50,189 miles for points and prizes during the six-week challenge. As a result of the charity target of 50,000 miles being met, Miles for Smiles received £500 for the charity.

A celebration event to mark the end of the game was held on Saturday 29th April in Eureka Park. Awards were presented to the winners of the game (listed below) and it was a great opportunity to showcase local community groups and organisations in Swadlincote who had taken part in and supported the game.

Girls Football

On International Women's Day in March, we partnered with East Staffordshire Schools Sports Partnership to host an event as part of the FA and Barclay's Biggest Ever Football Session.

Girl's football truly is in full swing in South Derbyshire with a fantastic number of schools participating in the event, showcasing their schools brilliant clubs, teams and female players. With approx. 300 primary school girls and 30 secondary school female leaders attending.

Bikeability Update

2023 for the South Derbyshire Active Schools Partnership Bikeability team has brought many changes and an increase in the amount of children we deliver to across the district. The ASP made the decision to replace our aging fleet of bikes after being in service for the past 10 years and to buy new racking for the vans to be able to store and carry them without damage. We looked at a number of options and settled on Cuda Bikes as they were lightweight and bright orange – fitting in with our corporate colours.



Our old bikes have been gifted to a cycle donation charity (Pushbike Paul) at Treetops Hospice in Risley, just on the district borders. This scheme is organised by an incredible group of local people, who together, refurbish and sell the bikes in aid of Treetops Hospice and many other charities. Upon receiving the bike, they set to work trying to turn them into affordable bicycles that local people can use to bike to shops, work or school and raise as much money for the charity, helping those that need respite care, support for the families affected by life limiting illnesses or bereavement in Derbyshire.

As mentioned, we have also increased our participation figures and delivered Balanceability to a record 900 reception children across the district, plus over 200 Learn 2 Ride places. We will also be starting the second stage of our Bikeability programme delivering Bikeability Level 2 to Year 6 children across the district, teaching them road craft and safety before they embark on their journeys to Secondary school and beyond. The team are looking forward to the delivery of Level 2 and at present we have over 400 children places booked to the end on July 2023.
